Root position, $V^{\frac{6}{5}}$, $V^{\frac{4}{3}}$, or $V^{\frac{4}{2}}$.

- a. Write the inversion under each chord,
- b. Write the letter names over the Treble staff.

(The spacing is going to be taller, to accommodate the extra height of StaffWriter's symbols used in the inversions.

You can lessen this space by making the inversion numbers a smaller point size than the rest of the text.

We've used 18pt., 20 pt., and 24 pt. below. The Roman Numeral is 24 pt.

(Or, you can use text boxes for the inversion numbers as we have mentioned in the other figured bass Help files.)
